

# HORIZONTAL, VERTICAL OR CEILING INSTALLATION

## Prior to initial start-up

Check the D4H Infrared Panel Heating System for any visible signs of damage and check that all the corresponding accessories have been provided.

The panel must not be used if any signs of damage are found. In such cases, please contact GL & Partners OG immediately

## Start-up

Install the D4H Infrared Panel Heating System using the installation set provided and connect it to the electrical power supply.

## Mounting the panel

No specialists are required – the light-weight D4H Infrared Panel Heating System is easy to install yourself. Use the mounting bracket provided to mount the D4H Infrared Panel Heating System to the wall or the ceiling. Dowels, screws, screwdriving bit and drill bit are also provided.

Once you have found the ideal spot for the D4H Infrared Panel Heating System on the wall or ceiling, insert the 6 mm drill bit provided into your drilling machine and drill into the wall.

Take the 6 mm dowel and insert it into the hole drilled into the wall.

Fix the wall bracket using the screw and the corresponding screwdriving bit so that the bracket can still be moved. Repeat this step another 3 times moving in a clockwise direction.

Use the corresponding screwdriving bit to fix the wall bracket firmly to the wall or ceiling. Now you are ready to mount the D4H Infrared Panel Heating System.

Mount the wall bracket for the room thermostat as well. Likewise, the dowels, screws, screwdriving bit and drill bit are provided.

## Electrical connection

The D4H Infrared Panel Heating System is equipped with a flat power plug. Once the panel has been correctly mounted, plug in the flat power plug into a 230 V power socket and switch the power switch on the D4H Infrared Panel Heating System to “on”. To adjust the room temperature (can be adjusted individually for each room), programme the thermostat provided with whichever room temperature gives you with that “feel-good” feeling.

We recommend not throwing away the original packaging of the D4H Infrared Panel Heating system, but to keep it for future transportation (e.g. should you later move house, etc.).
